Ethno-diagnosis

How do you know you have it (what complaints, problems, and symptoms would you see)?

Probe for use and means of self-diagnosis, use of specialists (who?), criteria used when choosing who and how to do this. Probe for uncertainties.

Ethno-etiology and prognosis

What happens to people who get it?

Ethno-epidemiology

Who has the problem (age, sex, or other differences?)

How do adults get it? Men? Women? How do children get it? Boys? Girls?

FOR EACH:

Ethno-"preventative medicine"

What can you do to prevent it?

Probe for differences by age, sex, etc., and for problems (emotional, social, physical, etc.) people encounter when they use one or another means of prevention.

Ethno-"curative medicine"

What can you do to get rid of it?

Probe for differences by age, sex, etc., and for problems (emotional, social, physical, etc.) people encounter when they use one or another means of "cure."
